Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6A of the Inter State Water Disputes Act, 1956 (33 of 1956), the Central Government had notified a Scheme called Narmada Water Scheme 1980 vide notification No. S.O. 770(E) dated 10th September, 1980 (as amended from time to time) inter-alia constituting the Narmada Control Authority (hereinafter referred to as the Authority) and the Review Committee to give effect to the decision of the Narmada Water Disputes Tribunal published in the Official Gazette notification No. S.O. 792(E) dated 12th December, 1979; and whereas under Sections 3 and 7 of the Narmada Water Scheme (as amended from time to time), and in supersession of the existing recruitment rules for the posts in Narmada Control Authority except with respect to the things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Narmada Control Authority hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Secretary; and Chief Engineer (Civil) in the Narmada Control Authority, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement:** (i) These rules may be called the Narmada Control Authority, Secretary; and Chief Engineer (Civil), Recruitment Rules 2021.

(ii) They shall come into force with immediate effect.
2. **Application:-** These rules shall apply to the post specified in Column (1) of the Schedules annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of Posts, classification and scales of pay:-** The number of the said posts, their classification and the level in the pay matrix pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedules annexed to these rules.
4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.:-** The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
5. **Disqualifications:-** No Person-
 - a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax:-** Where the Authority is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and with the approval of Chairman (NCA) relax any of the provisions of the rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving:-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Class, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
